#5 Now reads: Students living along 950 West between 1191 South and Mattea Lane, and students living on the north side of Mattea Lane, should walk to the intersection of 950 W and Mattea Lane. Students should then walk north on the west side of 950 West until they reach 1050 West. They will then cross and arrive at the school.

#6 Now reads: Students living on the south side of Mattea Lane, but north of the tracks, should walk to the intersection of 1325 S and 950 W and cross to the north side of Mattea Lane. From this point, students should walk north on the west side of 950 West until they arrive at the school.
